The 53 students received support in the form of preparatory courses in the language of the country where the internships took place, vocational English and classes with a psychologist and a career counsellor. Support was also provided for travel costs, accommodation and meals, city transport costs, excursions budgeted by the sending and intermediary organisation. The remaining amount from individual support and travel costs was paid to the participants as 'pocket money'. Each student also received certificate confirming the internship abroad and a 'Europass Mobility' document..
